- After reading a fiction book with your child, ask, "What do you know about (character)? What words does the author use to show you?
- ⇒ While reading a nonfiction book with your child, ask, "What new information did you learn from the captions?"
- ⇒ Counting by 2's, 5's and 10's. If your child can easily count these ways, start on a different number: 2, 7, 12, 17... or 32, 42, 52...
- Discuss ways to be Safe, On Task, Always Respectful, and Responsible

We began the week reviewing what we have written in our chapter books, looking for places we need to add more information or make changes!



What Do You Want to Be When You Grow Up?

This week we discussed why people work and how people decide what job they would like to do. The students completed an interest inventory and then compared their interests to list of jobs. Each student chose several occupations that they may like to do one day. Next week, each student will be researching one career they are interested in doing. They will look for information about what kind of training is required, what kinds of tools does one need to do the job, and whether the job provides a good or a service to the people in the community.

We also learned about <u>needs and wants</u>. Needs are what people require to survive, such as food, water, shelter, and clothes. Wants are the things that we would like to have, but don't require them to survive. We discussed the differences between needing a new pair of shoes and wanting a pair of shoes that light up or have a favorite character on them. The students learned that people in the community have to make decisions each day about what to spend their money on, and that they should pay for their needs before they spend money on their wants!
