Skills to practice at home:

- ⇒ Help your child learn to identify visually and know the value of coins.
- ⇒ Give your child 4-5 numbers between 10 and 100 and have him/her put them in order from least to greatest OR greatest to least.
- ⇒ After reading a fiction book with your child, ask, "What do you know about (character)? What words does the author use to show you?
- ⇒ While reading a nonfiction book with your child, ask, "What new information did you learn from the captions?"
- ⇒ Compare numbers using the terminology "greater than" "less than" and "equal to".
- ⇒ Discuss ways to be Safe, On Task, Always Respectful, and Responsible

What's Going on in eLc

Math Adventures

This week we have begun adding two digit numbers. In the initial part of learning this skill, we are NOT just lining up the numbers in a place value chart and adding. The students are using linking cubes to help them understand when they are adding ones and when they are adding tens. On paper, the students are making proof drawings by using "quick tens" (long straight lines) and ones (circles or x's). Through this method the students are already seeing that when they add two numbers that add up to be ten or greater, they need to make a new group of ten! They are grasping the concept of regrouping. After they have a firm understanding of these concepts, we will get to adding by lining the numbers up in a place value chart.

On March 27-28, we will have some very important visitors at our school! Forest Lake is going through a process to receive our STEM accreditation. We do so many wonderful things with science, technology, engineering and math at our school, and during these two days we will be showcasing them for the reviewers.
